Heritage Gold joins NSX



Heritage Gold NZ Ltd warrants (NSXCODE: HGDHXHA) began trading on NSX on 1 July 2002. Heritage is the first international company to become an issuer on the NSX. Heritage is a mineral exploration company that has been active, principally in New Zealand, since it was incorporated in 1985. It currently explores for gold in the Coromandel region of New Zealand and for cobalt near Broken Hill in Australia.

There are a number of mineral interests that the company has:

- Trackaringa Cobalt Project (near Broken Hill)
- Waihi North Gold Project
- Karangahake Gold Project (near Martha mine in NZ) and
- Onemana Gold Project

The company has 980 shareholders that are located within Australia and overseas. Its warrants are also listed and traded on the NZSE. The company was first listed on the NZSE in September 1986 and on the ASX in 1987.

The NSX listing means that Heritage warrant holders can trade and settle Heritage warrants within Australia. The latest annual report for Heritage is available on the NSX website.
