Material factors affecting the revenues and expenses of the issuer for the current period

As a result of Nu West defaulting in its contractual obligations and failing to pay the agreed \$1,000,000 Master license fee and the subsequent termination of their licence the company had to substantially cut overheads which has now been achieved. The strategy of licensing the technology to third party licensees on a combined license fee and royalty basis has been slower to implement as a result of the need to substantially cut overheads which has put a Major load on a very limited Human resource base. This workload had been increased dramatically as a result of unusual Audit Activity by Government Departments, compliance and audit associated with being a listed company, property market downturn and lack of working capital to fund required Human Resource.

A description of each event since the end of the current period which has had a material effect and is not related to matters already reported, with financial effect quantified (if possible)

Scurrilous legal activity by a shareholder has cost the company in many ways, particularly in the waste of time of scarce human resource and also in the incurrence of unnecessary legal bills.

Capital Raising of \$500,000 and the appointment of two new Directors was approved by shareholders at the 9th August 2005 EGM and since then the placement has been completed with Bernard Ross Nove and Geoffrey Allan Thomas having been appointed as Directors
