Basis of accounts preparation

If this statement is a half yearly statement, it is a general purpose financial report prepared in accordance with the listing rules and AASB 1029: Half-Year Accounts and Consolidated Accounts. Material factors affecting the revenues and expenses of the issuer for the period

The Company continued to make substantial share trading profits as a result of a buoyant market for resource company stocks in the first 7 months of the current period. Volatility in the share market from August made it difficult to continue to share trade profitably. Administration expenditure increased as a result of \$12,051 interest paid on a long outstanding debt, \$128,340 legal charges were incurred in relation to the Cloncurry Metals Ltd option and other agreements, and executive fees increased as a result of Messrs M Leggo and C Leslie providing a full 12 months of services. Exploration expenditure was reduced as a result of \$442,573 being recovered from Cloncurry Metals Ltd in accordance with the option agreement on the Pegmont tenements between the parties.

A description of each event since the end of the current period which has had a material effect and is not related to matters already reported, with financial effect quantified (if possible)

The sharemarket has experienced extreme volatility since the end of the current period with significant decline in many share prices making it difficult to make profits. The company has earned minor profits since 31/12/2007 which could easily turn into losses depending upon realisation. However, since the Company has cash balances, there is no reason to sell investments at distorted prices.

Franking credits available and prospects for paying fully or partly franked dividends for at least the next year
