Yes, I was a director of Maple Oil NL (an oil company) which went into administration after its bankers determined that its revenue streams from its share of production of the Inland Oilfield part owned by it would not be sufficient to repay capital and interest due to those bankers.

Maple Oil NL's downturn in revenue which caused that result resulted from decreased production rates from the Inland Oilfield at the time, transportation and storage problems in relation to production and a fall in the oil price to approximately US\$12 per barrel.

I became a non-executive director on 25/11/1993 and remained as a director throughout the subsequent administration and receiverships and resigned as a director on 26/11/1999 shortly before the company was readmitted to quotation on ASX after completion of a capital raising and finalisation of a deed of company arrangement.

STEPHEN ANDREW HAWKE and TRACY JOY DARE of KPMG were appointed administrators on 05/06/1998 and resigned on 21/12/1999. Various receivers were also appointed and retired during that period. Details of the receiverships are available if required.

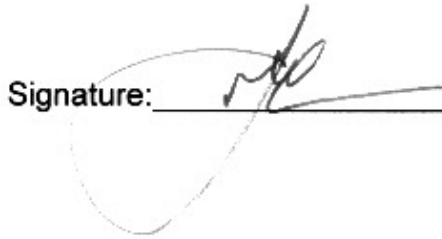

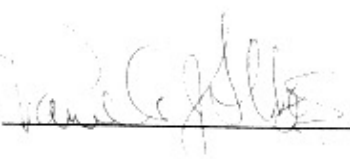
