## **NSX – GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENT**

Directors have received the preliminary findings of the metallurgical bench tests conducted on 17 (out of 19) samples in the series collected from five 1 metre diameter pits excavated through overburden, and/or directly into old tailings in that portion of the ground held under licence MIN5492, at Glenfine, not previously investigated.

These five pits are situated in an area also selected for tube sampling. Four parallel lines of sample points, at line space 15 metres, controlled the positions of points for tube sampling at 10 metre intervals along these lines. Separate samples for analyses were collected at successive depths, at each point. A total of 133 samples were forwarded for assay. Directors have received reports of the gold values for all 133 samples, but not yet values for other elements.

It is not appropriate to simply list these assay results. The Company is preparing to release a drawn section representing through actual results along one line, the unusual gold distribution here. An indication of the elevated gold values found is provided in the recently up-dated "Chairman's Outlook" as posted on the web-site of Mount Rommel.

Today's reading of these analyses is that at Glenfine the old tailings hidden under the present surface represent a very welcome building block for this Company in Year 2009. Release of further assay data (soon) will provide shareholders with reasons to appreciate why the reclaiming of these old tailings needs to be pursued at the earliest opportunity
