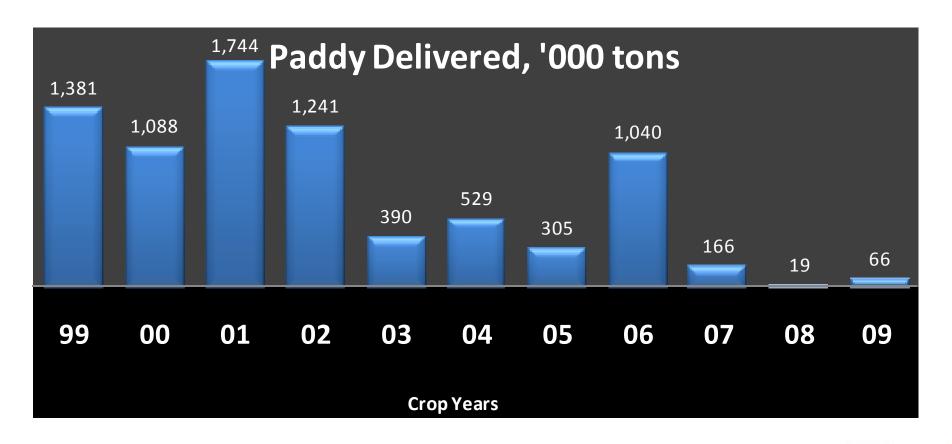

# C2008 Review (May 08 - Apr 09) Crop = 19 KT

- Lowest crop since 1929
- Coleambally & Deniliquin Mills remain in care and maintenance program
- Carry over from C07 was 105KT
- Heavy reliance on Global Sourcing continued



# C08 Marketing Highlights: Domestic

#### **Market Performance**

- RL share of rice category is 69%. SunRice share of rice category at 56%
- Microwave Rice is 14% of total rice category. SunRice share 52%
- Rice Cakes: SunRice share at 52%
- Entered Ready to Go Meals category with four products in top 10 sellers
- Developed and launched 17 new value added products

  - Upgraded packaging design







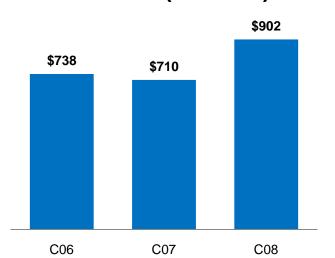
# C08 Operational Highlights

- International: Skills and capabilities upgraded in subsidiaries and international locations to maintain the best quality across the supply chain

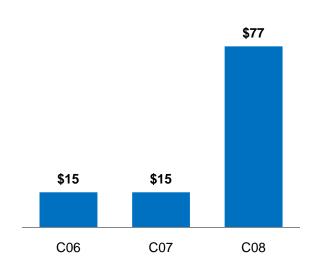

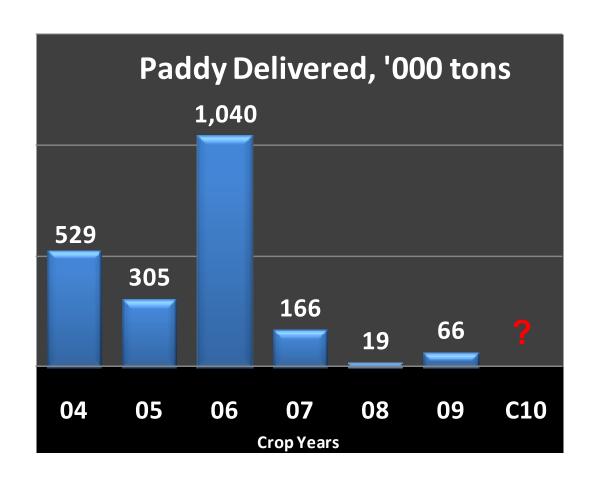

- Heavy reliance on international rice sourcing





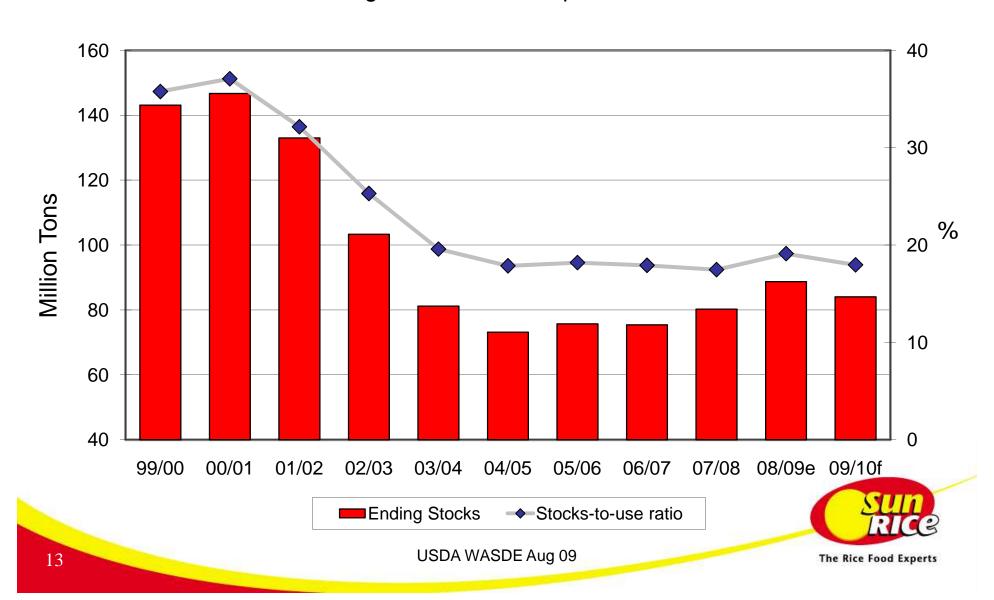
# Water Availability: A Key C10 Issue
