Report on the result of the ballot

We have audited the accompanying result of the ballot as at 18 March 2010 of Florin Mining Investment Company Limited, which encompasses the proxy forms received in accordance with the Notice of Meeting dated 5 February 2010 and votes counted at the meeting held on 18 March 2010.

Directors' responsibility for the result of the ballot

This responsibility includes establishing and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the result of the ballot that is free from the material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the result of the ballot based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Standard on Assurance Engagements ASAE 3000 Assurance Engagements Other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information. ASAE 3000 requires us to comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the result of the ballot is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the disclosures in the result of the ballot. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the result of the ballot, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the register result of the ballot, in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the overall presentation of the result of the ballot.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.
