NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE HALF-YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2011

NOTE 1: BASIS OF PREPARATION

These general purpose financial statements for the half-year reporting period ended 31 December 2011 have been prepared in accordance with requirements of the *Corporations Act 2001* and Australian Accounting Standards including AASB 134: Interim Financial Reporting.

This interim financial report is intended to provide users with an update on the latest annual financial statements of Fremantle Community Financial Services Limited (the Company). As such, it does not contain information that represents relatively insignificant changes occurring during the half-year within the Company. It is therefore recommended that this financial report be read in conjunction with the annual financial statements of the Company for the year ended 30 June 2011, together with any public announcements made during the half-year.

As disclosed in the financial statements, the Company had net current liabilities of \$160,588 and net liabilities of \$99,519 as at 31 December 2011

The Directors believe that it is reasonably foreseeable that the Company will continue as a going concern and that it is appropriate to adopt the going concern basis in the preparation of the financial report after consideration of the following factors:

- 1. The Company is profitable and generating positive cash flow from operations;
- 2. The business activities are supported by Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Limited, including assistance with the preparation and review of the Company's annual cash flow budgets;
- 3. Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Limited has confirmed that it currently provides working capital by way of an overdraft facility of \$430,000; and
- 4. The provision of additional funding by Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Limited is dependent upon the Company fulfilling its ongoing responsibilities under the Franchise Agreement and continuing to work closely with Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Limited management to further develop the business. The Company believes that it is fulfilling these responsibilities.

The same accounting policies and methods of computation have been followed in this interim financial report as were applied in the most recent annual financial statements, except in relation to the matters disclosed below.

New and Revised Accounting Standards

In the current year, the company has adopted all of the new and revised Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board (the AASB) that are relevant to its operations and effective for the current annual reporting period. The adoption of these new and revised Standards and Interpretations has not resulted in a significant or material change to the company's accounting policies.

NOTE 2: OPERATING SEGMENT

The Company operates in a single segment being the financial services sector as a branch of Bendigo and Adelaide Bank Ltd in Western Australia.

NOTE 3: CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

There has been no change in contingent liabilities since the last annual reporting date.

NOTE 4: EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO REPORTING DATE

No matters or circumstances have arisen since the end of the financial period that significantly affected or may significantly affect the operations of the Company, the results of those operations, or the state of affairs of the Company in subsequent financial years.
