Dear Shareholder / Grower,

Following an outstanding harvest, strong financial results and the reopening of Deniliquin Mill in 2011, I am delighted to announce the reinstatement of the Coleambally Rice Mill to assist with the expansion of SunRice's export operations.

As you know, 2011/12 marked the second consecutive season of full rice production in the Riverina with a harvest topping 963,000 tonnes.

The reopening of the Coleambally Rice Mill will create 34 new jobs to help process additional tonnes received during the 2011/12 harvest and boost the company's overall export capacity. We will be investing \$2.3 million to re-commission the Mill in the coming months, with its continued operation reviewed each year based on future crop outlooks and business needs.

This is a sound decision for SunRice, our growers and shareholders and of course a wonderful outcome for the people of Coleambally.

There will be marked community benefits from this decision, including the creation of local jobs, a boost to local businesses and an optimistic outlook for the entire area following what has been a difficult number of years for the growing region.
