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INFORMATION RELEASE – GLENFINE

In December, 2013, Mount Rommel Mining Ltd. as a Company were awarded an Australian Government R.&D. grant. This grant (as funds of approximately \$98,000) came in recognition of the design and testing completed for the purpose of reticulating exceptionally difficult pulp - the major portion of the Glenfine tailings material.

This award gives clear recognition to the outcome of persistent efforts by two Directors, Hamish Hunt, and Rodney Bradshaw. The consequence of these efforts is that a new technique exists for Carbon-in-Pulp processing, which Directors believe will deliver gold from the unusual tailings at Glenfine.

Total Fire Bans, and the associated prohibitions for tools and equipment, meant no on-site fabrication could take place at Glenfine site in the post-holiday period.

In lieu, off-site fabrication has been taking place, to prefabricate necessary new pulp reticulation hardware.

The first of the specially prefabricated sections were positioned at Glenfine site on Monday 17th February, 2014. Continuing installation is scheduled for Thursday of this week.
