INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS, AND TO THOSE EXPLORING FOR GOLD

The photo below is evidence that the Activated Carbon removed from the innovative batch plant operational at Glenfine, in Victoria, carries gold.



The photo is of the inlet pipe to the E-cell, shown to be plated with fine gold.

This photo was taken yesterday, during the initial trials of the Zadra E-cell fabricated here in Melbourne to USBM specifications (1952 vintage). The Zadra process is an invention of about year 1950. The Zadra technological breakthrough is described here – <http://mininghalloffame.org/inductee/zadra>.

Today's information release (to NSX only) confirms that the innovative batch process plant at Glenfine, and Zadra know-how, can indeed be put together, to produce new gold.

As operators become more familiar with the routines of both the Glenfine plant and the Zadra cell, expect greater efficiencies, and consequently recovery of more "lost" gold.

We say Mount Rommel Mining Ltd. has developed that combination of activities likely to set in play changes in public attitudes towards gold exploration.

Those who deferred exploration for gold, especially in Victoria, need to take note of these current events, going into year 2016.

We believe the plant innovations at Glenfine, which are designed to be fast batching, will be shown to address productivity in a way which also leads to changes in exploration strategy.

In addition, the mini-size of the plant arising from these innovations has the capacity to significantly improve the working environment, as is demonstrated within Glenfine Heritage site.

Members should be very pleased with progress in the current Quarter, 2015. The Zadra E-cell will continue to be operated through to the New Year break.
