

Chairman report.

Welcome to our Winter Newsletter to keep you advised of your **Community Bank®** branches and what has been happening this financial year both operationally and in the communities which we serve.

Firstly, our financial performance continues to improve, with our half year Profit after Tax of \$30,724, up \$65,609 on corresponding period last year, and up \$29,834 on 30 June 2016 full year results.

A major factor contributing to our improved result has been our move to the new Bendigo Bank financial model, Funds Transfer Pricing (FTP) in October 2016. We have spoken in recent Annual Reports of how the new pricing model would bring increased revenue supporting increased business growth, which as at the half year reporting period showed growth of \$17.7million (+7.1%) across our branches.

In early March, Westpac at Kincumber and Wyoming closed, providing us with further growth opportunities, particularly at Kincumber where we were in direct competition with Westpac. The closure of Westpac Kincumber has provided us with more opportunities being the only banking provider to service Kincumber, Avoca, Copacabana, McMasters Beach, Killcare

and Saratoga/Davistown. We have seen a significant increase in new accounts.

In October 2016 we welcomed new staff members Amie Ebert at Kincumber, and Darren Dean as Branch Manager to Lisarow. In February 2017 we employed our first Trainee, Ryan Gordon. The new staff are all fitting in well and we welcome them to our business.

Staff and Directors have been busy in the community with numerous events and presentations. I thank all Directors for giving their time and making an effort to ensure we offer our unique style of bank that supports community endeavours. 
Terrigal Matcham Cricket Club sponsorship.
