## GOOD FAITH CONSULTATION WITH DEBENTURE TRUSTEE IS PROGRESSING

I have previously reported in the NSX Market Update dated 8 October 2018 that the Loans Realisation Committee (LRC) requested Angas Securities Limited (Angas) to provide a high level report concerning the intentions of the Angas Board in the event that there will likely be insufficient time to realise all of the residual assets in the legacy debenture fund by 30 June 2019.

Angas duly compiled a formal written proposal outlining the various options being considered by its Board and management. This proposal was provided to LRC members on 12 October 2018 and discussed at length with me on behalf of Angas at the LRC meeting held on 26 October 2018.

Two Angas directors including me subsequently met with representatives of The Trust Company (Nominees) Limited ("Trustee") on 30 October 2018.

Since then, Angas has formally reported to the Federal Court on the alternative proposals under consideration. Orders were made by the Honourable Justice Beach on 8 November 2018 setting out a structure by which the parties should conduct their deliberations in good faith.

Significantly, these orders were made with the consent of the Trustee. His Honour entered the orders by consent without requiring the attendance of parties or counsel. This has saved legal costs for the investors.

The proceedings will be back before the Federal Court in the New Year.

Angas will continue to provide updates to the market as and when developments arise in respect of this process.
