Bendigo Telco (NSX: BCT) today announced its results for the year ended 30th June 2026.

The Group reported a strong financial result for the year ended 30 June 2026, delivering revenue of \$22.3 million, EBITDA of \$2.0 million and net profit after tax of \$1.05 million, representing growth of 788.9% over FY25. The result reflects the resilience of the Company's diversified telecommunications, managed IT and consulting services business and its ongoing focus on disciplined financial management.

Despite a challenging operating environment and the announced transition of telecommunications services by its largest customer, Bendigo and Adelaide Bank, Bendigo Telco remains confident in its future prospects. The Company has continued to strengthen its customer base and pursue opportunities across enterprise, government, not-for-profit and regional business sectors.

Throughout FY26, Bendigo Telco expanded its managed technology, cloud, cybersecurity and connectivity offerings while investing in systems, processes and partnerships that enhance customer experience and support future growth.

Looking ahead, Bendigo Telco remains focused on sustainable growth, innovation and customer success.

Chairman Rob Hunt stated, "While the Board is clearly focused on replacing revenue associated with the loss of a significant customer following their decision to transition to a tier 1 national provider, we remain optimistic about the future. Demand for our differentiated technology solutions, trusted service offerings and community-focused approach continues to grow. For more than 25 years, Bendigo Telco has supported customer success and regional prosperity, and we remain committed to delivering long-term value for our customers, shareholders and communities."

After careful consideration, the Board has elected not to pay a final dividend for FY26, preserving capital to support strategic investment, maintain financial flexibility and position the Company to create sustainable long-term value for shareholders.
