Ordinary Business

1. Receipt of Annual Report

To receive the Company's Financial Report, the Directors' Report and the Auditor's Report for the year ended 30 June 2007.

2. Election of directors

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass each of the following resolutions as an ordinary resolution.

- (a) That Edward John Coulter be re-elected as a Director of the Company.
- (b) That Barry Francis Godley be re-elected as a Director of the Company.
- (c) That Russell James Simpson be re-elected as a Director of the Company.
- (d) That Libby Patricia Williams be elected as a Director of the Company.
- (e) That Douglas Grahaeme Anderson be elected as a Director of the Company.

Libby Williams has had 11 years experience in the Banking and Finance industry and has been a Business Proprietor (IGA Augusta) for 11 years.

Doug Anderson has had 33 years experience in the Banking and Finance Industry with nine years experience in Senior Management.

3. Appointment of auditor

Attending the meeting

If more than one joint holder is present (including by proxy), the joint holder whose name appears first in the register may vote.

Corporate shareholder: A corporate shareholder may appoint one or more persons to act as its representative under section 250D of the Corporations Act, but only one representative may exercise the corporate shareholder's powers at any one time. The Company requires written evidence of a representative's appointed to be given to the Company before the Meeting.

Proxy: If you are unable to attend the Meeting, you are entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote. See the attached Proxy Form for information on appointing a proxy.

Voting rights

Each shareholder is entitled to **one** vote.

For the purposes of voting at the Meeting, shares will be taken to be held by the persons who are registered as members as at 5.00pm on 26 November 2007.

Agenda item 2: Election of Directors

The following information is provided about candidates for election to the Board.

- (a) Edward John Coulter, retires in accordance with the constitution of the Company, and being eligible, offers himself for election.

How to complete the Proxy Form

1 Your name and address

This is your name and address as it appears on the company's share register. If this information is incorrect, please mark the box and make the correction on the form. **Please note, you cannot change ownership of your shares using this form.**

2 Appointment of a proxy

A member entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting may appoint one proxy. A proxy need not be a member of the Company. A proxy may be an individual or a company.

3 Identity of proxy

If you wish to appoint the Chairman of the Meeting as your proxy, mark the box. If the person you wish to appoint as your proxy is someone other than the Chairman of the Meeting please write the name of that person. If you leave this section blank, the Chairman of the Meeting will act as your proxy.

4 Voting instructions

You may direct your proxy how to vote by placing a mark in one of the boxes opposite each item of business. If you do not mark any of the boxes on a given item, your proxy may vote as he or she chooses. If you mark more than one box on an item your vote on that item will be invalid.

5 Signing instructions

The Proxy Form must be signed in the spaces provided.

Individual: If the holding is in one name, the holder must sign.

Joint Holding: If the holding is in more than one name, any one holder may sign.

Power of Attorney: To sign under power of attorney, you must have already lodged this document with the Company or attach a certified copy of the power of attorney to this form when you return it.

Companies: If the Company has a Sole Director who is also the Sole Company Secretary, this form must be signed by that person. If the Company (under section 204A of the Corporations Act 2001) does not have a Company Secretary, a Sole Director can also sign alone. Otherwise this form must be signed by a Director jointly with either another Director or a Company Secretary. Please indicate the office held by signing in the appropriate place.

If a representative of the Company is to attend the meeting, the appropriate "Certificate of Appointment of Corporate Representative" must be produced before admission to the meeting.

Lodging instructions

This Proxy Form (and any power of attorney under which it is signed) must be received by the Company not later than 2 business days before the meeting (ie by 5.00pm on Friday 23 November 2007).
