- Due to very strong lending growth, profit for the year was above budget.
- Sponsorship payments, according to the accounts were \$223,000.
- Actual sponsorship payments including GST were \$490,000, due to the funding of a number of buses and other developments on a long term sponsorship basis.
- In banking terms, this is a magnificent result after just over 7 years of trading and the financing of budgeted losses made by our Ashburton branch.



- The Feasibility Study will involve the postal delivery of up to 15,000 surveys to households and businesses in Balwyn and surrounding areas.
- If you have received the survey, please complete it and return it to the independent accounting firm.
- If you have not received the survey, please collect one from one of our three branches.
- Four weeks after the surveys are delivered, the accounting firm will prepare a report to the steering com-mittee which will state whether or not, a profitable community bank branch can be established in Balwyn.
- To date, a significant amount of new business from the Balwyn area has already transferred to our existing three branches. The viability of a community bank branch in Balwyn is, in our opinion, beyond question.
- Once the report is received and a business plan on the Balwyn branch is written and agreed to by Bendigo Bank, we will issue a prospectus.
- The shares will be issued by Canterbury Surrey Hills Community Finance Ltd, the operator of the four branches.
- For 2009/2010, the existing shareholders received a 5 cent per share fully paid dividend and we expect to see a similar return on all shares issued, including those for the Balwyn campaign.
