Scope

We have reviewed the accompanying financial report of Doncaster East Community Financial Services Limited comprising the balance sheet, income statement, statement of changes in equity, cash flow statement, accompanying notes 1-4 to the financial statements and the directors' declaration for the entity for the half-year ended 31 December 2006.
