Dear Shareholders, customers and community members.

Welcome to our fifth birthday newsletter edition.

We hope you enjoy reading about the many initiatives underway at the East Ivanhoe **Community Bank®** Branch and also, around the country in the Bendigo Bank network.

We are very proud to have been able to celebrate our fifth birthday with many of you recently. It has certainly been an exciting five years for the community since the branch opened its doors in East Ivanhoe.

With your help, we are now able to boast more than \$90 million in banking business, in excess of 4500 accounts and our recent Company listing on the Bendigo Stock Exchange.

Since the launch on 12 May 2001, our records have shown a consistent upward trend in all areas of the business and we hope to continue to grow in this way.

One of the highlights of this growth has been our capacity to return some of this success to the community that has supported us.

This has been achieved through our popular Community Grants scheme and several local sponsorships, worth about \$70,000 to 30 local non-profit organisations.

We are pleased to report this year we have been able to substantially increase the funds available for community groups.

This year, the Bendigo Bank's charitable arm, Community Enterprise Foundation, will manage the distribution of the grants.

He is now the proud holder of an account with the branch


All customers who panked during the birthday month of May also received a chance to win one \$100 and two \$50 bank accounts
