Young People take control through Victorian Youth Foundation

An exciting and innovative Youth Foundation Victoria project has just been launched. The project gives young people the change to help grow their own communities and their prospects, and obtain first-hand philanthropic experience through the Foundation. As part of this unique State Government and Bendigo Bank project, young people from Victorian Communities will form local groups to determine the needs of their communities. With mentoring from local leaders, the groups will then undertake fundraising and grant-making to help other local young people solve those needs.

The **first** of 15 Victorian Youth Foundation Programs will be set up in Laverton due to a tremendous show of support from the Altona **Community Bank®**, Laverton / Altona Meadows **Community Bank®** and Point Cook Sub-Branch who have committed up to \$100,000 over four years to establish the local Laverton arm of the Youth Foundation Victoria.

- Working in leadership and decision-making roles
- Developing networking and community planning skills
- Volunteering based on stronger community connections
- Project management
- Communication and marketing; and
- Developing the attitudes and values that will enable them to effectively contribute to their communities.
