1. Basis of preparation of the half-year financial statements

Statement of compliance

Basis of accounting

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the members of South Burnett Community Enterprises Limited

We have reviewed the accompanying half year financial report of South Burnett Community Enterprises Limited, which comprises the balance sheet as at 31 December 2008, and the income statement, statement of changes in equity and cash flow statement for the half year then ended and other selected explanatory notes and the directors' declaration.

Directors Responsibility for the Financial Report

The directors are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the half year financial report in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards (including the Australian Accounting Interpretations) and the Corporations Act 2001.
