Comments on Results

A review of the operations of the economic entity during the financial year and results of those operations follows:

- The Society's operations are mainly conducted in Queensland and only comprise of activities normally associated with the Building Society industry. The operations comprise of the acceptance of deposits and the provision of loans.
- The consolidated pre-tax profit of the economic entity for the year was \$1,935,705, compared with a pre-tax loss for the previous year of \$1,167,570. This improvement resulted from an increase in income of \$988,615 and a reduction in expenses of \$2,114,659.
- Loan approvals for the year totalled \$96.2 million, which was slightly below last year's figure.
 Loan approvals increased over the year from \$42.3 million in the first half to \$53.9 million in the second half.
- Loan balances reduced by \$38 million over the year as a consequence of actions taken to restructure the lending portfolio. However despite this the Society's interest margin increased as a result of an improvement in the margin on deposit funds.
- The General Provision for Doubtful Debts was increased by a further \$505,000 and stood at \$2.8 million at 30 June 2004.
- Total assets increased by \$26 million over the year.
- Earnings per share increased to 13.39 cents per share (previous -8.51 cents per share). There are no instruments on issue having a dilutionary effect on earnings per share.
- Dividends for the year increased to 8.0 cents (previous 2.0 cents)
